The Women Enhancing Technology (WeTech) Qualcomm Global Scholars program is a partnership between the Institute of International Education (IIE) and Qualcomm that invests in young women and future leaders in science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) in China, India, Taiwan, and Korea. The scholarship recipient will be expected to complete a 6-month virtual mentorship from March through August 2018. Applicants must be able to communicate in English.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be female and a citizen of Taiwan
- Applicants must be a current second, third, or fourth year undergraduate student or graduate student at an accredited institution in Taiwan
- Applicants must be seeking a degree in Industrial Engineering, Communication Engineering, Electrical Engineering, or Computer Science
